Because individual members may only propose bills of a financial nature this year, we would ask that the Education Committee raise a bill that would allow parents to meaningfully participate in the education process by amending the general statutes to require the board of education to offer an option for parents to withdraw their child from a particular course or classes, without cause or explanation, unless such course or class is statutorily required. This proposal recognizes that parents should remain the ultimate authority in what their children are being taught in school.
