Reduce Tax Burdens for Veterans

Sen. Martin helped pass **H.B. 5491**, which provides a property tax exemption for fully disabled Veterans, helping to alleviate financial burdens for those who have given so much for our country.

Broaden Job Opportunities

Sen. Martin championed **H.B. 5299** to revise the JobsCT program and the Community Investment Fund 2030. He also worked with colleagues to pass **H.B. 5524**, which eliminates unnecessary college degree requirements for certain state jobs and opens doors for more residents.
